It can help combat depression, anxiety, and stress by increasing the number of endorphinsreleased by the brain.

The cost of the trip is 150 AED and is inclusive of additional offerings such as a 2-for-1 pass on your next visit anda delicious meal with soft drinks. 

How to register & pay for an activity online?

**Step 1:** Log in to GEMS Parent Portal with parent login credentials (Click here to log in).

Step 2: Click Enroll in Activities under Quick Links or click on the Activities tab on the left Navigation menu



Step 3: To register your ward, select the 'BOUNCE X' (respective grade)

- 1. BOUNCE X- KG 1
- 2. BOUNCE X- KG 2

Step 4: Select 'Request to Enroll'

Step 5: Click 'Send Request"
