International Educational Trip to Georgia and Armenia, 22nd – 27th March 2025

Dear Parents,

I am thrilled to announce an upcoming international educational 5 Nights/ 6 Days trip to Georgia and Armenia from 22nd March to 27th March 2025 for students of Grades 7, 8 and 9. The cost of this optional trip is AED 6,800/- per student. Please note that the schedule mentioned is subject to approval from the Knowledge of Human and Development Authority (KHDA).



Our trip to Georgia and Armenia promises to be an enriching and educational experience, featuring a well-planned itinerary, health and safety precautions, payment details, visa requirements, hotel accommodations, and food arrangements. Please read this circular carefully to ensure that you are fully informed and prepared for this exciting trip.

With the travel date approaching, immediate payment of the first installment is required, as the purchase of flight tickets depends on receiving payments by the specified deadline. Missing the payment deadline could impact the overall cost of the trip and potentially alter the travel dates.

Orientation

There will be an orientation for parents of students who have made the full payment in January 2025.

Expectations

It is essential to understand that this is a group activity organized exclusively for the school, and certain rules are in place to ensure the safety and well-being of all students. Students will not be allowed to go out in the evenings alone or unsupervised, and violations of school or safety rules may result in sanction as per the GLS Behaviour Policy being applied.

Visas

Georgia and Armenia are visa on arrival countries and there is no cost attached to the visa as of 01st October 2024. However, this is subject to consular discretion and may change closer to the departure date.

Hotel Reservations

Comfortable and convenient 4-star accommodation will be arranged for the duration of the stay in Georgia and Armenia on a triple-sharing basis. Students will share rooms with two or three students, and preferences will be considered where possible.

• Food Arrangements

Meals will be provided for students throughout their stay in Georgia and Armenia. Please notify us in advance of any special dietary needs or allergies, so we can make the necessary arrangements. Once payments are finalized, a separate form will be sent to gather this information. The trip cost includes all meals, so your child will only need extra money for snacks, treats, or souvenirs. Additionally, all transportation within Georgia and Armenia is covered in the trip fee. One teacher or supervisor will accompany every group of 10 students on the trip.

Additional Requirements

A complete list required for the travel will be provided to students who have confirmed their interest. Please find below list of documents that are mandatory:

- Passport with 6 months validity
- Original Emirates ID with 6 months validity
- A valid residency visa with 6 months validity
- Flight itinerary & hotel bookings (to be provided by Compass Int'l)
- Detailed itinerary (to be provided by Compass Int'l)
- Travel Insurance (to be provided by Compass Int'l)
- NOC letter from school

Kindly complete the appended consent form, ensuring it is filled out and signed by a parent, and return it to the class teacher along with the payment of the first instalment, which can be made via the parent portal by 10th October 2024. Please find appended the steps for payment. This will allow us to confirm accurate numbers and secure consent for each student attending the trip. The portal for the 2nd instalment will open on 1st November 2024.

We are excited to embark on this educational journey to Georgia and Armenia with all of you and look forward to creating unforgettable memories together!


